

ALZHEIMER'S DISEASE AND RELATED DISORDERS EMPLOYEE TRAINING SUBSTITUTIONS

As an employee what training do I need?

Assisted Living Facility Employees:

Initial 4 hours within 3 months;
additional 4 hours (direct caregivers only) within 9 months.
Direct caregivers must also participate in a minimum of 4
contact hours of continuing education each year.

Adult Day Care, Hospice and Nursing Home Employees:

Initial 1 hour within 3 months of hire date
Additional 3 hours within 9 months of hire date

Home Health Employees:

2- Hour curriculum within 9 months of hire date

Does training at a previous facility/agency meet requirements for my current position?

NH, ADC and HSP training substitution for HH must include 1 and 3 hours
 NH, ADC and HSP training substitution for ALF Level 1 must include 1 and 3 hours.
 NH, ADC and HSP 1-hour "direct contact" training cannot substitute for NH, ADC or HSP "direct care" 3-hour training.
 Direct caregivers must take all 4 hours.
